CPR-AED Training:

- 1) Wednesday - March 4 , 1:20 - 4:10 p.m., Knight Club-Powell Campus Center;

Fee: Students - \$7 to cover the cost of the face mask; the course is free to all faculty and staff. If you already have a face mask, and bring it to the class there will be no charge for the mask.
