Moody's Investors Service Reaffirms AU's Baa1 Rating

I am pleased to inform you Moody's Investors Service has reaffirmed Alfred University's Baa1 rating and stable outlook. This is the same rating and outlook we received in November 2007, before the current economic downturn that has had such a negative effect on colleges and universities. We feel very fortunate to retain our rating when 20 other colleges and universities so far this year have been downgraded, and 55 others received a negative outlook.

Moody's is the most respected source for credit ratings, which help investors analyze credit-worthiness of borrowers. Thus, the Moody's rating affects the attractiveness to future lenders, determining our ability to borrow, particularly on the bond market, and the potential rates at which we can secure borrowing, should we decide to do so.

In its comments, Moody's praised our management team's knowledge and its action plans for dealing with the uncertain times ahead.

Moody's affirmation of our credit rating and our stable outlook are a credit to all those who have

worked so diligently to maintain our enrollment and produce balanced operating budgets, both important factors in Moody's rating. I would like to extend our appreciation to all of you for your efforts, particularly Giovina Lloyd, interim vice president for business and finance; Wendy Beckemeyer, vice president for enrollment management; Suzanne Buckley, provost and vice president for academic affairs; Stanley Colla, vice president for university relations; and Tammara Raub, controller, who participated in the review process.
