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### AU MSDS Online User Class

Beginning with the Fall 2009 semester, Environmental Health and Safety is offering a new training class for faculty, staff, and students who wish to utilize our MSDS Online system. Knowing the hazards in and around your work area, lab, or classroom is essential to your personal health and welfare.

Employees of Alfred University are required by OSHA to become familiar with the hazards in and around their work place. The best way to recognize hazards is by reading the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) of those hazardous products or chemicals you have the potential to come in contact with.

This is an introductory class to the MSDS Online system. Using individual computers we will access Alfred University MSDS Online, search for MSDS's located around the campus, assess some MSDS's for applicable content, review some of the features available via the MSDS Online system, try to answer any specific questions you might have and if time allows, take a look at other relevant information available via the Environmental Health and Safety web site.

The class is free to a faculty, staff, and students. Due to the limited number of computers available in the classroom, we will accept the first 20 people who pre-register.
