French Speaking Africa Fall 2010

French Speaking Africa

This course is an introduction to the cultures and literature of French-speaking Africa with readings and discussions of works by contemporary Francophone African writers and poets, also using films to supplement the readings. This is an elective for the major and minor in French as well as Global Studies. It also fulfills the Global Perspectives Gen Ed requirement. It is only offered once in a while, so this will probably be a good chance for your students to take. Among the topic discussed in this course will be: art, history politics, gender, religion , culture, rites of passage, rituals and music. We often invite guest speakers who teach an African course or who lived in Africa. The course will offer the student a cultural exposure, raises their awareness and broaden their knowledge of a non western world.

The course will be taught in English by a native francophone African who will bring her own personal experience and perspectives to share with the class.

Chemical Waste Removal

The spring/summer chemical waste removal will occur during June 2010. Both hazardous and non-regulated waste will be accepted.

All chemical waste must be received in your respective Central Accumulation Area (CAA) no later than Wednesday, June 2, 2010.

Advanced Waste Solutions will be packaging for transport on June 7 and 8. NYSCC contact Dean x3020 (Harder Hall CAA) or Shanti x2497(McMahon CAA); non-statutory AU contact Dean x3020 to arrange for receipt of your waste in Myers Hall CAA.

All Satellite Accumulation Area labels MUST be filled out completely with EPA# for respective college, building name, Room # or area name, start date, initials, chemical name(s) of constituents in the accumulation container with volume or weight, and waste characteristics prior to receipt in Central Accumulation.

Note: Per EPA regulations you have only 72 hours from an SAA full date to transfer the container to the proper CAA. SAA containers must be capped or sealed with container lid, have clean exterior, and SAA label easily legible.

If you have any questions contact Dean Perry.

All Satellite Accumulation Areas must be empty prior to May 28, with a notation to that effect made on your submitted June 10 Satellite Accumulation Area Weekly Inspection sheet.

Completed Hazardous Waste and Non-Regulated Waste Log Forms must be sent to Dean Perry no later than Thursday, May 27 and may be mailed (117 Myers Hall), faxed to x2086, or e-mailed to: perrydr@alfred.edu. Advanced Waste must have this information prior to packing in order to obtain required approvals from the TSDF.

Hazardous Waste Log Forms are available at <http://our.alfred.edu/ind...> under the heading "AU EH&S Forms".

You may still accumulate waste and add to your list notifying Dean of the additional waste by faxing or e-mailing a NEW waste log sheet adding the word "Amended" to the title no later than Wednesday, June 2.

Alfred State Wellsville Campus/Sinclair Site Remediation Project

On Tuesday, May 11 at 7 p.m. a representative from British Petroleum will update and explain the status of the old refinery remediation project moving into its final phase on the Wellsville Campus of Alfred State College. Project Manager, Eric Larson will present a brief video and discuss construction plans that will finalize the treatment of groundwater flowing under the campus property.

Constructed wetlands are already online and functional, transportation systems in place, so the collection and containment of the water are the last construction aspects to the treatment project.

Once the engineering is in place, a significant section of the riverbed in Island Park that has been exposed to contaminants will be removed and replaced.

The presentation will be given in the Council Room of the Culinary Arts building on the Wellsville campus. Representatives from the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will be in attendance. Sponsoring this event are the Upper Genesee River Chapter of Trout Unlimited and British Petroleum.
