Seeking Faculty Input on Technology/Media Outreach

"I'm looking to hear from current academics who were in college when computers first started to be integrated into campus life. Roughly, this would encompass academics who finished their undergrad schooling in 1984, '85, '86 or '87. I'm interested in profiling a generation of academics who have spent their careers sandwiched between 1) older colleagues who might be resistant to technology, and 2) younger colleagues who are "digital natives" and don't remember academe before computers. How has being in this position affected how they view technology and the upheaval it has caused in higher education?
