SAILS Test

In the fall of 2010, the Alfred University Libraries administered the Standardized Test of Information Literacy Skills (SAILS) for the second time. The purpose of the test is to measure students' ability to find, retrieve, analyze, and use information, also known as information literacy.

The libraries are excited to report that from 2007 to 2010 Alfred University students showed improved scores in seven out of eight skill sets, including retrieving sources; selecting finding tools; understanding economic, legal, and social issues; searching; developing a research strategy; evaluating sources; and documenting sources.

This noteworthy improvement is evidence of the success of efforts by AU's faculty and librarians to promote information literacy skills campuswide. Kudos to all!
