Laurence Juber is a two-time Grammy award-winning fingerstyle acoustic guitarist, also known for his electric work as lead guitarist in Paul McCartney's Wings. Juber has released 15 critically acclaimed solo albums which feature his celebrated arrangements of popular tunes and genre-crossing compositions.

A highly celebrated guitarist, he was voted "Guitarist of the Year" by the readers of Fingerstyle Guitar Magazine and named one of the top acoustic guitar players of all time by Acoustic Guitar Magazine. In the fall of 2010, he released the highly anticipated "LJ Plays the Beatles Vol. 2".

The library-sponsored concert is free and open to the general public at the Nancy Howe Auditorium in Wellsville.
