On July 11, the Wingate Memorial Summer Carillon Recital Series will commence with guest artist, John Widmann, City Carillonneur for 25 years in Frederick, MD. John has performed in the Netherlands, England, Canada, the US, and the Netherlands Antilles. John will perform a varied program including pieces by Bach and Mendelssohn, carillon originals, "Pure Imagination" from Willie Wonka and the Chocolate Factory and a medley from Walt Disney's Beauty and the Beast. The program will start at 6:30 pm due to the MostArts Festival concert at 7:30 pm.

The Wingate Summer Series honors the first university carillonneur, Dr. Ray Wingate, professor of organ, who served as carillonneur from the arrival of the bells in 1937 until his death in 1968. This summer's series is dedicated to Margaret Wingate Rase (1919-2016), president of the Foundation for 49 years.
