Our Academic Calendar allows one week of "Add" and two weeks of "Drop" in a Semester. So, the last day to register for Fall Semester or to add a Fall class on BannerWeb is Sunday, September 3. Any registration or "adding" after that can be accomplished only by using a paper form that must be signed by your advisor and Dean.
