

AU in 10th place after first day at men's Alpine skiing national championships

LAKE TAHOE, CA Alfred University is in tenth place after the first day of competition at the United States Collegiate Ski Association (USCSA) national championships, being held through Saturday, March 8. Alfred is among 19 teams competing in the championships in Lake Tahoe, CA. The giant slalom was held Thursday, with the slalom event scheduled for Saturday. Alfred's top skier Thursday was sophomore Jared Mostue (Hopkinton, NH/Proctor Academy) with a 36th-place finish. Junior Matt Seavey (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) was right behind in 37th place, while freshman Ryan Fuller (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) was 62nd. Sophomore Angus Graham (Bethel, ME/Gould Academy) and freshman Tyler Ledge (Ketterly Point, ME/Gould Academy) did not finish their runs.
