

AU men's lacrosse team victorious in season opener

GENEVA - The Alfred University men's lacrosse team won its 2003 season opener, defeating SUNY Oswego 19-11 Friday evening in a game played at Hobart College. The contest was tied at 7-7 after two periods. Alfred (1-0, 0-0 Empire 8) broke the game open by outscoring Oswego (0-1, 0-0 SUNYAC) 7-2 in the third period and 5-2 in the fourth. Junior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) led the Saxons with four goals and six assists. Junior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) had three goals and three assists, while senior midfielder Steve Douglas added four goals and an assist. Rounding out the scoring for Alfred were senior midfielder Greg Gascon (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) with three goals and an assist, junior midfielder A.J. Fiorelli (Endicott/Union-Endicott) with a pair of goals and an assist, and junior attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes), freshman midfielder Carlo DiRisio (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) and senior midfielder Frank Radell (Henrietta/Rush-Henrietta), each with a goal. Sophomore Nichol Hohman (Gibsonia/Pine-Richland) went the distance in goal for AU, making 15 saves to notch his first collegiate victory. Alfred is in action next at 4 p.m. Wednesday, March 12, when the Saxons travel to California to take on Whittier College. Whittier (4-0) is ranked fifth nationally among Division III teams.
