

AU Appoints Assistant Professor of Electrical Engineering and Physics

Alfred, NY -- David Szczerbacki, acting dean of the College of Engineering and Professional Studies at Alfred University, announces the appointment of Dr. Jalal Baghdadchi as assistant professor of electrical engineering and physics. Baghdadchi earned a Doctor of Philosophy degree in electrical engineering in June 1999 from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. He received a Master of Science degree in electrical engineering in 1994 from North Carolina A&T, and a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering in 1992 from the University of Massachusetts. He served as a research associate at North Carolina A&T from January 1998 until his appointment to the AU faculty post. He was an instructor in the Department of Electrical Engineering at North Carolina A&T from January 1995 to December 1997. Baghdadchi's research interests include fault tolerance theory; computer architecture, VLSI design; and artificial intelligence, evolutionary computing and fuzzy logic.
