

## AU men's lacrosse team falls to Clarkson in Terrence O'Connor Tournament finals

ALFRED Clarkson University scored 11 unanswered goals against host Alfred University to win the title game of the Terrence O'Connor men's lacrosse tournament Sunday at Merrill field. Alfred (4-1, 0-0 Empire 8) held a 5-2 lead with 12:45 left in the second quarter but failed to score the rest of the game. Clarkson trailed 5-4 at the half and outscored the 17th-ranked Saxons 7-0 after intermission. Sophomore attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) led AU with three goals. Sophomore attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) had on goal and two assists, while senior midfielder Bill Crehan (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) scored one goal. Midfielder Mike Burgess (four goals, one assist) and attack Sean Pearce (three goals, two assists) paced Clarkson. AU senior goalie Kevin Kazmierczak (West Seneca/Orchard Park) kept Alfred in the game, recording 21 saves. Clarkson netminder Joe Zebrowski stopped nine shots. In the consolation game Sunday, Lycoming defeated Brockport 11-4. Midfielder Dave Dormand led Lycoming with four goals, while attack Sang Duong had two goals and two assists. Attack Mark Vastola had two goals and an assist to lead Brockport. Lycoming goalie Christian Willaum had 36 saves; Brockport goalie John Contatto had six. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, March 30, at 1 p.m. at home against Hartwick.
