

AU women's lacrosse team evens record with win over Battling Bishops

ALFRED An 11-1 run in over the final 15 minutes of the first half and the first 10 of the second half keyed an 18-14 win for the Saxons over the Ohio Wesleyan Battling Bishops (4-3, 1-0 NCAC) Junior attacker Chris Sanford (Bowdoinham, Maine/Mt. Ararat) led the scoring barrage with seven goals for Alfred (3-3, 0-2 Empire 8). Junior attacker Kelly Farrell (Meriden, N.H./Kimball Union Academy) also had a career day with six goals and one assist. Also scoring for the Saxons were senior midfielder Kimberly Fank (Farmingville/Sachem) with two goals and an assist and senior attacker Katie Sedgwick (Manlius/Fayetteville-Manlius) and freshman midfielder Jessica Giuricich (Blairstown, N.J./Blair Academy) with one goal apiece. Junior Jessica Dunster (Auburn/Auburn) played most of the game in goal, making 10 saves, before giving way to senior Anora Burwell (Rochester/School of the Arts) midway through the second half. Sophomore Carrie Williams led Ohio Wesleyan with four goals and one assist, followed by freshman Liz Stockdale, sophomore Lila Barzegar and senior Amanda McDermott with three goals each. Freshman Ashley Pritchard played the entire game in goal for OWU, stopping 11 shots. Alfred's next game will be Monday afternoon at 4 p.m. in Fredonia.
