

## **AU men's lacrosse team beats St. John Fisher**

ROCHESTER The Alfred University men's lacrosse team defeated St. John Fisher College on the road Wednesday evening by a 14-10 margin. The Saxons (3-3 1-1 Empire 8) started off strong, building a three-goal advantage off of six first period goals. The team put away seven more goals in the second half to seal the victory. Leading AU was senior midfielder Steve Douglas (Horseheads/Horseheads), who had three goals and two assists. Junior attacks David Vail (Mt. Lakes, N.J./Mt. Lakes) and Dylan Macro Camillus/West Genesee) each had three goals and one assist. Junior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) chipped in with two goals and two assists, while senior midfielder Gregory Gascon (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) added one goal and one assist. In goal, sophomore Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, Pa./Pine Richland) played the bulk of the game, making 13 saves and giving up eight goals in 57 minutes, before giving way to senior Matt Jones (Waterloo/Waterloo). For Fisher, Jay Schickling had three goals and one assist, while James Schutt had three goals. Joe Alonge went the distance in the nets, making 19 saves. The next game for the Saxons will be this Saturday, April 5, when they host Rochester Institute of Technology at 1 p.m. on Merrill Field.--
