

## **SUNY Geneseo drops Saxons**

ALFRED The Alfred University men's lacrosse team was defeated by SUNY Geneseo 20-14 Wednesday afternoon on Merrill Field. The Saxons (3-5, 1-2 Empire 8) fell behind early and trailed by a 7-2 deficit after the first quarter. AU then rallied in the second period, coming as close as 8-7 before Geneseo broke away for the victory. Leading AU was junior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan), who had a game-high six goals. Also contributing was junior attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) with two goals and seven assists, five of which came on goals by Archer. Senior midfielder Gregory Gascon (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) and junior midfielder Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union Endicott) each chipped in with two goals. In goal for the Saxons, sophomore Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, PA/Pine Richland) played the bulk of the game, recording nine saves in 54 minutes. Senior Matt Jones (Waterloo/Waterloo) finished up in the nets, adding one save. For the Knights, junior Mark Engel had four goals and two assists, while junior Tim Killoran had four goals. Junior Andy Howk played the first three quarters in goal, making seven saves. The Saxons will next be in action on Saturday, April 12, when they travel to Ithaca College for a 1 p.m. start.--30--
