

AU women's lacrosse team falls to Wooster

ALFRED The Alfred University women's lacrosse team was defeated by Wooster College 20-9 Saturday afternoon on Merrill Field. The Saxons (3-7, 0-4 Empire 8) fell behind early and trailed by 12-1 at halftime. Despite a strong second half, AU was not able to overcome this early deficit. Junior attack Chris Sanford (Bowoinham, Maine/Mt. Ararat) led the Saxons, scoring four goals and adding an assist. Junior attack Kelly Farrell (Meriden, N.H./Kimball Union Academy) chipped in with two goals, while senior attack Katie Sedgwick (Manlius/Fayetteville-Manlius) added one goal and one assist. Freshman midfielder Jessica Giuricich (Blairstown, N.J./Blair Academy) and senior midfielder Kimberly Fank (Farmingville/Sachem) rounded out AU's scoring with one goal each. Junior Jessica Dunster (Auburn/Auburn) started in goal, making 11 saves. Senior Anora Burwell (Rochester/School of Arts) relieved Dunster with 12:32 remaining in the second half and made two saves.
