

Hillel at Alfred Announces Schedule for Jewish High Holiday services

Alfred, NY -- Services for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, the holiest days of the Jewish calendar, will be held on the Alfred University campus and at Temple Beth El in Hornell. For both Rosh Hashanah (Sept. 10-12), the two-day celebration of the Jewish new year, and Yom Kippur (Sept. 19-20), the Day of Atonement, services on the Alfred University campus will be led by Larry Greil, Hillel advisor as well as professor of sociology and health policy, and by student members of Hillel at the University. Hillel is sponsoring an erev Rosh Hashanah dinner (erev means "eve of"), an erev Yom Kippur dinner, and a Break Fast meal. Meals are at Howell Hall on the University campus. The dinners are \$5 for members and \$10 for nonmembers, and the Break Fast meal is free for members of Hillel and \$10 for others. Reservations for the Yom Kippur dinner are due by Sept. 13; no more reservations for the Rosh Hashanah dinner are available. Hillel membership costs \$25. In addition to reduced prices for High Holiday meals, members get reduced rates for Sunday brunches, the Passover Seder, and other activities. The schedule of services is: Rosh Hashanah Friday, Sept. 10 -- 5 p.m. service, Howell Hall; 7 p.m., evening services, Temple Beth El, Hornell. Those who need a ride should meet at 6:30 p.m. at Howell Hall. Saturday, Sept. 11 -- 10 a.m., Howell Hall, morning service; noon, Kanakadea Creek, Tashlich; 7 p.m., Temple Beth El, evening service. Those needing rides should meet at 6:30 p.m. at the AU Physical Plant. Sunday, Sept. 12 -- 8:30 a.m., Temple Beth El, morning service. Those needing transportation should meet at 9:30 at Physical Plant. (The group doesn't plan to arrive at the beginning of the very long service.) Yom Kippur Sunday, Sept. 19 -- 5 p.m., Howell Hall, dinner; 6:30 p.m., Temple Beth El, Kol Nidre (evening service). Those needing rides should meet at 6:30 at Howell Hall. Monday, Sept. 20 -- 10 a.m., morning service; 5 p.m., concluding service, followed by the Break Fast meal, all at Howell Hall.
