

Alfred University women's lacrosse team drops road contest to Nazareth College

ROCHESTER The Alfred University women's lacrosse team traveled to Nazareth College Thursday afternoon and dropped a 14-5 decision to the host Golden Flyers. Nazareth (5-2, 4-0 Empire 8) scored the game's first eight goals and held a 12-3 lead at halftime before both teams scored twice after intermission. Alfred (2-4, 0-2 Empire 8) was paced by junior midfielder Katie Sedgwick (Manlius/Fayetteville-Manlius) with two goals and an assist. Senior midfielder Lindsay deCsipkes (Unionville, PA/Unionville) scored a goal and an assist while sophomore attack Chris Sanford (Bowdoinham, ME/Mt. Ararat) and senior attack Sheilah Higgins (East Northport/Northport) each scored one goal. Freshman midfielder Mandi King (Hilliard, OH/Hilliard Davidson) had one assist to round out the Lady Saxons' scoring. Sophomore Jessica Dunster (Auburn/Auburn) starter in goal for Alfred and made 14 saves in 50 minutes of action. Junior Anora Burwell (Rochester/School of Arts) played the final 10 minutes. Allison Roberts scored five goals and added an assist to pace Nazareth, while Shawna Kabot and Stephanie Smolos each had three goals. Teryn Wineburg and Lindsey Burgess split time in goal for the Golden Flyers, combining to make 16 saves. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, April 6, at 2:30 p.m. at Utica.
