ALFRED, NY The Alfred University Orchestra, under the directions of Dr. Lisa Lantz, professor of music, will present its fall concert on Sunday, Nov. 19, at 7:30 p.m. in Miller Theater.

Focusing primarily on Baroque music, three soloists will be featured. Flutist Christiana Lehmann and violinist Vit will perform the Concerto Grosso by Handel; Vit will join violinist Mackenzie McDonald for the Bach Double Violin Concerto.

Lehmann is a senior from Pleasant Valley, NY, majoring in art and design; Vit is a sophomore from Canandaigua, NY, majoring in mechanical engineering and history with a minor in mathematics; and McDonald is a first-year student from Reston, VA, majoring in art and design.

Sunday's concert is free and open to the public.
