

## **Saxons fall on the road to RIT**

ROCHESTER The Alfred University men's basketball team lost their third straight game Saturday evening, dropping a 70-64 decision to host Rochester Institute of Technology. The Saxons (9-10, 4-5 Empire 8) shot 50 percent from the field in the first half, and held a halftime lead of 37-35. RIT turned the tables in the second half, however, and pulled ahead for the victory. Leading the Saxons were senior forward Brock Stortini (Amenia, NY/Arlington) and senior guard Tanner Webb (Newark, NY/Newark) who each had 12 points. Stortini added six rebounds. Senior guard Devon Downing (Canton, OH/Glenoak) chipped in with 11 points. Guard Brandon Redmond of RIT led all scorers with 25 points and eight rebounds, while forward Michael Stanton had 15 points in the winning effort.
