Our newest initiative, APEX (Applied and Experiential Learning) is almost ready! Students who will be juniors and seniors in the fall can apply for \$1000 awards to support internships, co-ops, study abroad, undergraduate research, service learning and much more. While these experiences have always been important components of an Alfred University education, APEX is one of the only programs of its kind that provides funding directly to students to support them. For this first pilot year, we are offering 200 awards of \$1000 to the first 200 students to complete an approved application. Applications will open July 1. Parents of current first-years and sophomores, don't worry! By the time your child is a junior, our plan is to increase awards to \$2000 with no limit on the number of students who are eligible. It's a short wait but worth it!
