

Sixty-plus Employers To Be Represented At Alfred University's Career Fair

Alfred, NY -- If you want to get a job, change jobs, or even change careers, Alfred University's career fair will give you a chance to see what's available. You might even find a job immediately. Set for 1-5 p.m. Thursday, March 18, in the McLane Center gym, the fair is open to students from other colleges, AU alumni, and the general public as well as current AU students. There's no charge. The event is co-sponsored by the University's Career Development Center and the Alfred student chapter of the Society for Human Resource Management. Representatives of more than 60 companies are attending the fair to hire people for both permanent jobs and summer, co-op, and internship positions. The firms range from the American Camping Association, which is looking for summer workers for jobs around New York state, through the Kohler Co. of Kohler, WI, which needs ceramic and mechanical engineering graduates, to Zampell Refractories of Newburyport, MA. New companies this spring include Atto Technology Inc. of Amherst, Client Logic (formerly Softbank), St. Joseph's Villa of Rochester, and Paychex Inc. Also attending will be Wal-Mart Distribution Center, Orthstar Inc., Kane Magnetics International, Excel Communications and Techneglass. Job-seekers are encouraged to bring many copies of their resumes. AU students can use the Career Development Center's 24-hour resume critique service. There will also be a workshop on "How to Work the Career Fair" at 5 p.m. Monday, March 15, at the CDC on campus.
