

AU track teams compete at Albany

ALBANY The Alfred University men's and women's outdoor track and field teams competed at the University at Albany Invitational over the weekend, with the men placing 11th out of 26 teams competing and the women placing 12th of 20. Junior Michael Cook (Auburn/Auburn) was Alfred's top performer with a second place in the 10,000-meter run (33:36.80). Other top-10 finishes for AU were turned in by sophomore Stephen Robin (Foster, RI/Ponaganset), fourth in the pole vault (4.30 meters); sophomore Nate Corney (Walwort/Gananda), sixth in the 110-meter hurdles (16.23) and eighth in the 400 meter hurdles (1:01.42); sophomore Casey Lesar (Mechanicville/Mechanicville), seventh in the 400-meter hurdles (1:00.50); freshman Craig Zarzycki (Gansevoort/Schuylerville), seventh in the high jump (1.79 meters); sophomore Matthew Oakes (Ellington/Falconer), ninth in the javelin throw (40.23 meters); freshman Davis Cook (Auburn/Auburn), 10th in the 5,000-meter run (16:38.85); and junior Nick Coleman (Waverly/Waverly), 10th in the 200-meter dash (23.21 seconds). Senior Tyeisha Pugh (Queens/Humanities & Arts Magnet) led the AU women's team with a second-place finish in the 3,000-meter steeplechase (12:26.04). Freshman Catherine Kautz (Harvard, MA/Bromfield) was third in the 3,000-meter run (10:54.86). Sophomore Maureen McGlenn (Elmira/Thomas A. Edison) was 15th in the 800-meter run with a time of 2:50.85.
