

## **Trustees Task Force holds second meeting**

The Trustees Task Force to Study Greek Life at Alfred University held its second meeting from 9 a.m. to noon on Thursday, March 7. According to Chairman Gene M. Bernstein, the task force heard reports from Gerald Brody, vice president for Student Affairs, and Daryl Conte, assistant dean of students and coordinator of Greek Life. Among the topics they reported on were the percentage of Alfred University students belonging to fraternities and sororities, currently and historically; how the grade-point average of students who belong to Greek organizations compares to the all-student GPA; and what efforts have been made by the University over the past decade to strengthen Greek life. Scott Hooker, director of Admissions, spoke to the task force about the degree of interest in joining a fraternity or sorority expressed by prospective students. The Task Force will meet again March 20th to continue its assessment of Greek life at Alfred and around the country. Bernstein has scheduled Task Force meetings for every two weeks with a goal of presenting at least interim recommendations to the Alfred University Board of Trustees at its May meeting.
