

## **AU football team shut out at Ithaca**

ITHACA The Alfred University football team lost at Ithaca College, 30-0, Saturday afternoon. Alfred was held to 106 yards in offense and was shut out for the first time in six years. Ithaca (1-0, 1-0 Empire 8) scored twice in the first 6:28 to take a 14-0 lead. The second touchdown came one play after an Ithaca interception gave the Bombers possession deep in AU territory. Ithaca added a touchdown and field goal to take a 23-0 halftime lead and finished off the scoring with a touchdown in the third. Alfred (0-2, 0-2 Empire 8) couldn't get its offense going. The Saxons managed 66 yards rushing and 40 yards passing and were held to 10 first downs. Senior tailback Jesse Raynor (Weedsport/Weedsport) had 67 yards rushing on 20 carries. Backup sophomore quarterback Craig Zarzycki (Gansevoort/Schuylerville) played the second half, completing five of 15 passes for 37 yards. Tailback Pete Celebre paced the Ithaca offense with 116 yards rushing and a touchdown. Quarterback Josh Felicetti threw for 243 yards and two touchdowns, both to wide receiver Vince Dargush, who finished with six catches for 90 yards. Alfred plays its home opener Saturday, Sept. 20, at 1 p.m. against St. Lawrence.
