

AU women's volleyball team drops two at Hartwick Invitational

ONEONTA, NY The Alfred University women's volleyball team lost two matches Friday, Oct. 3, in the first round of the Hartwick Invitational Tournament. Alfred (2-18, 0-2 Empire 8) lost its opening match 3-0 (30-27, 30-17 and 30-25) to Plattsburgh State. Sophomore Beth Sanger (Greece/Greece Arcadia) led the Lady Saxons with 10 kills and nine digs. Sophomore Catherine Rieck (Walworth/Gananda) had six kills and 12 digs, senior Amanda Vizcarra (Gasport/Royalton-Hartland) had 12 digs and sophomore Deen Genzardi (Oneonta/Unatego) had 16 assists. Sophomore Katie Goetschius (Wellsville/Wellsville) had four kills and three service aces. In its second match, Alfred fell to Skidmore 3-0 (30-21, 30-20 and 30-21). Goetschius paced the Lady Saxons with four kills, seven digs and two service aces. Sanger had six kills and nine digs while Genzardi added 14 assists. Freshman Sarah Berry (Mora, MN/Mora) chipped in with four kills and three blocks. Alfred wraps up play today with matches against Plattsburgh at 11 a.m. and Hartwick at 1 p.m.
