

AU cross country teams compete at Hamilton Invitational

CLINTON, NY The Alfred University cross country teams competed Saturday at the Hamilton College Invitational meet. Fifteen teams competed, with both AU teams placing third. The top runner for the AU men's team was senior Michael Cook (Auburn/Auburn), who completed the eight-kilometer course in 27:21.70 for an eighth-place overall finish. Cook's time was two minutes better than the time he posted at last year's race at Hamilton. Junior Ryan Bank (St. Johnsbury, VT/St. Johnsbury) was 15th with a time of 27:47.5 and junior Dan Burnett (Spencerport/Spencerport) was 20th with a time of 28:15.20. Sophomore Catherine Kautz (Harvard, MA/Bromfield) was the top runner for the AU women's team, finishing the three-mile course in 20:06.10 for a 24th-place finish. Freshman Anna McClaugherty (Alliance, OH/Alliance) placed 29th with a time of 20:16.40, while sophomore Elaine Heimers (Warwick/Warwick Valley) was, 34th with a time of 20:26.50. The AU cross country teams compete next on Saturday, Oct. 25 at RPI.
