

Saha receives award for work on orthopaedic implants

Dr. Subrata Saha, professor of biomedical materials engineering science in the School of Engineering at Alfred University, received the Orthopaedic Implant Award, given by the International Society of Medical Implants and Devices at the first International Conference on Medical Implants in Bethesda, MD. At the conference, Saha chaired the Maxillofacial Implant Symposium in honor of Dr. Robert Christensen, an inventor of temporomandibular joint (TMJ) and dental implants. Saha, his students and colleagues on the AU faculty presented a total of 14 papers at the conference, more than any other institution.
