

## **Alfred Trio to present concert Nov. 9**

The Alfred Trio, featuring violinist Lisa Lantz, cellist Rintaro Wada, and pianist David Peter Coppen, will perform at 3 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 9, in Susan Howell Hall on the Alfred University campus. The concert will feature the music of French composer Gabriel Faure. The program will open with Violin Sonata in A major, followed by Elegy for cello and conclude with a very late work by the composer, the Piano Trio in D minor. The concert is free and open to the public. Lantz is an associate professor of music and symphony orchestra conductor at Alfred University. She performs with the Alfred Trio and is working on a book as the official biographer for the internationally renowned violinist, Aaron Rosand. Lantz holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Toledo, a Master of Music degree and a Specialist in Music Performance from the University of Michigan, and a Doctor of Music Arts degree from the Ohio State University. Wada is originally from the Tokyo area of Japan. He teaches orchestra in the Bolivar-Richburg Central Schools, where he joined the faculty in 1999. Wada holds a Master of Music from Eastman School of Music and a Bachelor of Arts degree and post-graduate diploma in cello performance from Showa College of Music. Coppen is a member of the Music Library Association and the Society for American Music. This past April, Coppen performed the Grieg Piano Concerto with the Alfred University Symphony Orchestra. Coppen holds a Bachelor of Music from the University of Michigan, Ann Harbor, and a Master of Science degree and Certificate of Advanced Study in library and information science.
