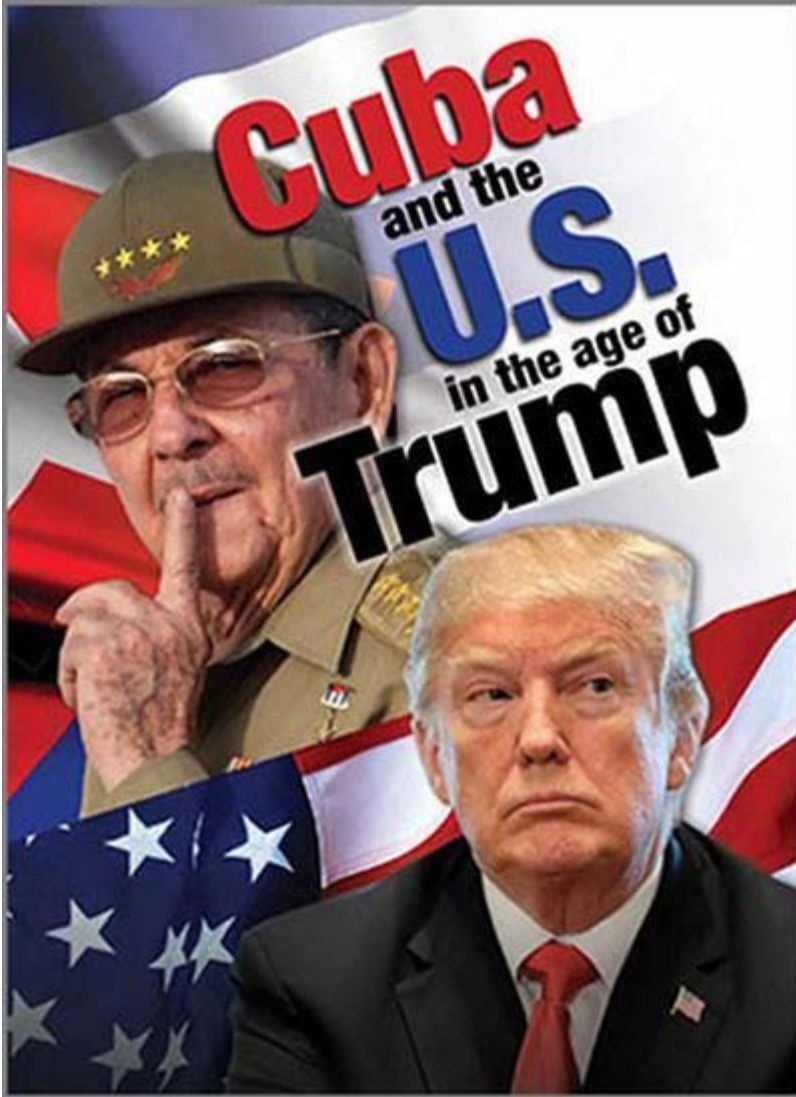


Journalist to give talk at Alfred University on Cuba-United States relations

ALFRED, NY Arnold August, a journalist based in Montreal and an expert on Cuba, will be at Alfred University on Wednesday, April 18, to present a talk titled "Cuba and the U.S. in the Age of Trump."

August's talk, which will discuss the threats and opportunities that Cuba faces on the literal eve of its historic April 19 presidential election, will be held at 6:30 p.m. April 18 in Nevins Theater, Powell Campus Center. Sponsored by the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and presented by the Global Studies Program, the talk is free and open to the public.

Following the talk, August will be signing his most recent book, *Cuba-U.S. Relation*. August has a master's degree in political science from McGill University. His other books include *Democracy in Cuba and the 1997-98 Elections* (1999), *Cuba and Its Neighbours: Democracy in Motion* (2013), and *Cuba-U.S. Relations: Obama and Beyond* (2017).

An accomplished journalist, August contributes articles in English, Spanish and French to websites in the United States, Canada, Cuba, Latin America and Europe and speaks at major universities and research centers in the U.S., Canada, and Cuba.
