

Lady Saxons lose home opener

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's basketball team lost to the Blue Knights of Geneseo, 63-28 Tuesday evening. The Lady Saxons (1-4, 0-0 Empire 8) struggled offensively, only shooting 31 percent from the field and turned the ball over 27 times in their first loss at home this season. Pacing Alfred was sophomore center Kylee Knoll (Elmira/Elmira) who lead the team in scoring and rebounds with six points and seven rebounds, respectively. Junior Michelle Kelly (Levittown/General Douglas MacArthur) had a strong game with five points and two assists.
