

Alfred University women's basketball team loses at home to Potsdam State

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's basketball team lost at home to Potsdam State, 54-44, Friday evening in the McLane Center. The teams were tied at 24-24 at intermission. Potsdam used a 48-36 rebounding edge to pull away in the second half. Neither team shot well, as Alfred made 28 percent of its shots and the visiting Lady Bears 36 percent. Alfred (1-5, 0-0 Empire 8) was led by junior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown/General Douglas McArthur) with 14 points and sophomore center Kylene Knoll (Elmira/Elmira Free Academy) with 10 points and six rebounds. Freshman guard Megan Sampsell (Corry, PA/Corry) had eight points and sophomore forward Meghan Coddington (Amherst, NH/Souhegan) added six points and a team-high 11 rebounds. Guard Kate Sullivan led Potsdam (2-2) with 15 points and nine rebounds, while forward Kara Miller netted a double-double with 10 points and a game-high 12 rebounds. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, Dec. 13, at 1 p.m. at home against St. Lawrence.
