

Saxons prevail in OT, top Hawks, 63-58

ONEONTA, NY Alfred's men's basketball team picked up its third win of the season, getting by a struggling Hartwick squad, 63-58, in overtime. Sophomore forward Ryan Hallett (Caledonia/Caledonia-Mumford) led the Saxons with 16 points, including four from behind the arc, and 12 rebounds. Sophomore guard Chris Lemasters (Mansfield, Pa./Mansfield) also finished in double figures, scoring 11 points. The rest of the team provided a very well-rounded effort with Tate Williams (N. Clarendon, Vt./Mill River Union), Dillon Stein (N. Huntingdon, Pa./Norwin), Bruce Nober (Lake Huntington/Narrowsburg) and Nick Andolina (Arkport/Arkport) all finished with at least eight points. Hartwick's sophomore guard Matt Guzielek sent the game into overtime with a three-point bucket with 42 seconds remaining, but the Saxons outscored the Hawks, 12-7, in the extra period, sealing the win. Alfred's next game will be Saturday afternoon as they visit the Utica Pioneers. Tip off is scheduled for 4 p.m.
