

Hawks steal victory from Lady Saxons

ONEONTA, NY Hartwick junior guard Maria Fernandez put the finishing touch on a 49-48 victory by nabbing the inbound pass with two seconds remaining, sealing a nail-biting win for the 11-8 Hawks. Strong efforts from sophomore center Kylene Knoll (Elmira/Elmira Free Academy) and junior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown/Gen. Douglas MacArthur) weren't enough to give the Saxons the win as they dropped to 3-15 on the season. Knoll finished with 14 points on 7-for-14 shooting, while Kelly added 10 points, including a pair of three-point buckets. Sophomore forward Meghan Coddington (Amherst, N.H./Souhegan) also contributed eight points and a team-high eight rebounds. Hartwick's senior center Heather McGuerty led the Hawks to their comeback from a 28-24 halftime deficit with 13 points and 10 boards. The Saxons next game is Saturday as they visit the Utica Pioneers. Tip off is at 2 p.m.
