

Men's lacrosse team drops season opener

BALTIMORE, MD -- The Alfred University men's lacrosse team lost its 2004 season opener, falling to Dickinson College, 15-10, Saturday afternoon in a game played Baltimore. The Saxons held an 8-7 lead after two periods before being outscored 8-2 in the second half. Alfred (0-1, 0-0 Empire 8) was paced by senior attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) with four goals and a pair of assists. Freshman midfielder Andy German (Wayne, PA/Radnor) netted three goals in his first collegiate game. Also contributing for AU were senior attack Trevor Archer (Pen Yan/Penn Yan) with four assists; sophomore midfielder Carlo DiRisio (Prattsburgh/Penn Yan) with two goals; senior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) with a goal and an assist, and senior midfielder Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union-Endicott) with two assists. Sophomore goalie Chris Wzsalek (West Seneca/West Seneca East) made 15 saves for Alfred. The Saxons are in action next on Wednesday, March 10, at 11 a.m. against Kenyon. The game will be played in Baltimore.
