

## **Alfred University men's lacrosse team rallies to knock off Hartwick**

ALFRED, NY -- The Alfred University men's lacrosse team defeated visiting Hartwick College, 17-12, Saturday afternoon at Merrill Field. The Saxons (4-1, 1-0 Empire 8) rallied from a 12-10 deficit late in the third period, scoring seven unanswered goals to close out the contest. AU snapped a four-game losing streak to the Hawks, who fell to 5-2 (2-1 Empire 8). Alfred trailed 5-2 after one period but outscored Hartwick 5-3 in the second to go into halftime down only a goal, at 8-7. Alfred trailed 12-11 after three periods, but tied the game 28 seconds into the final frame when junior defenseman Josh Parker (Hamburg/Hamburg) raced down the field on a clear and beat Hartwick goalie Mark Colite for his first career goal. AU freshman midfielder Andy German (Wayne, PA/Radnor) scored the eventual gamewinner 21 seconds later. German led Alfred with four goals and four assists while picking up a game-high nine ground balls. Senior midfielder A.J. Fiorelli (Endicott/Union-Endicott) added four goals, while senior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) had three goals and an assist. Senior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) and sophomore midfielder Carlo DiRisio (Prattsburgh/Penn Yan) each scored twice, with Archer assisting on two scores. Sophomore goalie Chris Wzsalek (West Seneca/West Seneca East) played the entire game in goal for Alfred, registering nine saves and shutting Hartwick out in the final quarter. Brian Prescott led Hartwick with four goals. Kevin Geraghty handed out five assists and Brian Miller scored twice. Colite finished with 12 saves in goal for Hartwick. Alfred plays next on Wednesday, March 31, at 7 p.m. at home against St. John Fisher.
