The Sept. 24 dinner is \$5 to members and \$10 to non-members. Reservations from the dinner must be made by Monday, Sept. 20. The Sept. 25 Break Fast meal is free to members of Hillel and \$10 to non-members. New members may join Hillel at Alfred for \$25. Benefits of membership include reduced rates at Sunday brunches, the Passover Seder, and other Hillel activities.
