

AU women's soccer team gets fourth straight win with shutout of Hilbert College

BUFFALO - The Alfred University women's soccer team netted its third straight shutout with a 3-0 victory at Hilbert College Tuesday afternoon. Three different players scored for the Lady Saxons (4-2-0, 0-0-0 Empire 8), who won their fourth straight after starting the season 0-2. AU has outscored their opponents 26-1 in during that stretch. Freshman midfielder Sarah Guest (Cohocton/Wayland-Cohocton) opened the scoring with just more than 10 minutes left in the opening half on an assist from sophomore forward Chelsea Hall (Elmira/Elmira Free Academy). Hall scored on an assist from senior midfielder Ashley Van Wie (Gloversville/Gloversville) with 9:15 left in the second half to make it 2-0 and freshman midfielder Alyssa Hatch (Allegany/Allegany-Limestone) closed out the scoring with an unassisted goal with five minutes left in regulation. Sophomore goalie Brianna Paquette (West Burke, VT/St. Johnsbury) made four saves to get her second shutout of the season. Hilbert goalie Wendy Brusso made 16 saves. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, Sept 18, at 1 p.m. at home against Ithaca.
