

Four alumni included in Fine Craft Show at Memorial Art Gallery

The fourth annual Fine Craft Show at the Memorial Art Gallery in Rochester features "one-of-a-kind and limited edition" work by 40 nationally acclaimed craft artists; four of them are Alfred University alumni. The participating artists, selected by juror Michael Rogers, chair of the School for American Crafts at Rochester Institute of Technology, "regularly participate in the nation's most prestigious shows," according to a spokesperson for the Memorial Art Gallery, 500 University Ave., Rochester. Alfred University alumni participating are: Linda Huey of Alfred Station, ceramic artist. She is a 1993 graduate. Joel O'Doriso of Corning, glass. He graduated in 1994. Paul Willsea and Carol O'Brien of Naples. Both are 1982 graduates of AU who work in glass. The Fine Craft Show will be held from 10 am to 5 pm Saturday, Nov. 13, and from 11 am to 4 pm Sunday, Nov. 14, at the Memorial Art Gallery. Tickets are \$6 each and are \$5.50 at the door. Advance tickets may be purchased for \$5 each and are available at all area Wegmans stores. All proceeds benefit the Gallery. A preview party will be held from 7-9 pm Friday, Nov. 12. Tickets for that event, which offers an opportunity to meet with the artists and purchase items in advance, are \$35, and include one day's admission to the show.
