

AU linebacker Brady earns weekly football honors from ECAC

ALFRED, NY Brenton Brady (Rochester/Marshall), a junior outside linebacker on the Alfred University football team, has been named Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Northwest Region co-Defensive Player of the Week by the Empire 8 Conference. Brady was honored for his play in the Saxons' 16-0 victory at Grove City Saturday afternoon, Oct. 30. He had seven tackles (four solo), including two for loss and a sack. He also had an interception (which he returned 27 yards), recovered two fumbles and defended two passes. With the win, Alfred improved to 7-1 on the season (3-1 in Empire 8 play). It is the team's best record after eight games since the 1981 team finished with a 10-0 regular season record and played in the NCAA playoffs. Brady shares the ECAC honors with Ithaca linebacker Jose Colon. Earlier this week, Brady and Colon were named co-Defensive Players of the Week by the Empire 8 Conference. AU is in action next on Saturday, Nov. 6, at 1 p.m. home against Ithaca. With victories over Ithaca and St. John Fisher (Nov. 13), Alfred would win the Empire 8 Conference title and earn an automatic berth to the NCAA playoffs.
