

## **AU football shutout for the first time this season**

ALFRED The Alfred University football team lost 24-0 to visiting Ithaca College Saturday afternoon in Empire 8 conference play. The defense played another solid game for AU (7-2, 3-2 Empire 8) holding Ithaca to 338 total yards of offense, 100 yards under the season average for the Bombers. Junior Brenton Brady (Rochester/Marshall) recorded 15 tackles, four for a loss, and a half sack for AU. Sophomore strong safety Aaron Meyers (Delevan/Pioneer) made 13 tackles while freshman Blake Fuller (Newark/Newark) had ten tackles and one sack for the Saxons. Freshman defensive end Ray Simpson (Hauppauge/Hauppauge) also had a sack to go along with his six tackles. The offense had a tough time getting started for the Saxons, finishing with 190 total yards and committing two turnovers. AU was unable to capitalize on multiple scoring opportunities, including a blocked field goal early in the first half and an interception thrown later in the game. Sophomore running back Chaz Bruce (Rochester/Marshall) was the highlight of the offense for AU rushing for 111 yards on 16 carries. Senior quarterback Ron Duliba (Forestville/Forestville) finished the game completing 17 of 34 passes for 115 yards and an interception. Junior TyQuan Horton (Syracuse/Corcoran) led all Alfred receivers with four catches for 31 yards. Dustin Ross had nine tackles and a sack for Ithaca (7-2, 5-1 Empire 8), while Ryan Terlecki chipped in with eight tackles. The Bomber offense was led by quarterback Josh Felicetti, who ended the game 21 of 29 passing for 204 yards and two touchdowns. Wide receiver Jamie Free ended the game with six receptions for 52 yards and a score. Alfred will play in their final regular season game on Saturday, November 13, at 1 p.m. home against St. John Fisher.
