

Alfred University men's soccer falls to St. John Fisher in shootout

ST. JOHN FISHER The Alfred University men's soccer team, seeded fifth, lost in the first round of the ECAC Upstate Championships Wednesday night in a six-shots-to-five shootout with fourth seed St. John Fisher. After ending regulation knotted up at 0-0, neither team was able to put one in net in two overtime periods sending the game into a shootout. Both teams connected on their first five penalty kicks forcing another round. After St. John Fisher goalie Pete Schatz saved AU's sixth shot off the foot of freshman Rian Morgan (Byron-Bergen/Byron), the Cardinals were able to put the game away when Orkan Cintugla placed their next shot attempt in the upper-left corner of the goal. Sophomore Brian Middleton (C.W. Baker/Baldwinsville) played the entire game in net for AU stopping one shot. Schatz ended the game with eight saves. The Saxons finished off a successful 2004 season with a 10-6-2 record overall and earned bids to play in the Empire 8 and ECAC tournaments.
