

## **AU professor's Recent Publications Include Essay, Poetry, Reviews**

Alfred, NY -- Ben Howard, the Fred H. Gertz Professor of English at Alfred University and an internationally known poet, published work in five journals this semester. His fifth collection of poems, *The Holy Alls: Poems 1994-1997*, will be also issued this summer by Salmon Publishing, an international publisher based in Ireland. Howard's recent work includes: "Buffaloed and Beguiled: Reciprocal Visions of Ireland and America," an essay that appears in the winter 2000 issue of the *Sewanee Review*, the oldest literary quarterly in the United States. "Secular and Sacred," a group of reviews of books by Eamon Grennan, Kenneth Koch, James Kimbrell, and Peter Cooley, appears in the April 2000 issue of *Poetry* magazine. One of the leading publications in the field, *Poetry* is distributed in 43 countries. The poem "A Discipline" appears in the current issue of *The Formalist: A Journal of Metrical Poetry*. "Winter Night," another poem, appears in the current issue of *The Amicus Journal*, the journal of the National Resources Defense Council. "A Given Name," a poetic sequence, has been published by the on-line *Cortland Review*, featuring RealAudio. It is found at [www.cortlandreview.com](http://www.cortlandreview.com). In addition, Howard was selected for inclusion in *Who's Who Among America's Teachers, 2000*, an honor bestowed on about 2.5 percent of college teachers nationwide.
