

## **Alfred University's Brady earns All-America football honors**

ALFRED, NY Brenton Brady (Rochester/Marshall), a junior linebacker on the Alfred University football team, has been named an honorable mention All-American by D3football.com. D3football.com is a leading source of on-line information on Division III football. The honorable mention given to Brady is the latest in a string of honors earned by the 6-0, 230-pound outside linebacker. The Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) has named him its 2004 Northwest Region Player of the Year, while Don Hansen's Football Gazette named him a First Team All-East Region All-Star. He was also named the Empire 8 Conference Player of the Year and a First Team all-Empire 8 selection. Brady finished the 2004 season with team-leading 96 tackles (54 solo), including 14 for loss and seven sacks. He led AU with four interceptions (one returned for a touchdown) and tied for the team lead with three fumble recoveries. Brady, the Saxons' short yardage run specialist, also rushed for 64 yards and four touchdowns. He was the leader of one of the top defenses in the Empire 8 and Upstate New York in 2004. The Saxons allowed 14.8 points per game and held opponents to less than 270 yards of offense per contest. AU concluded its 2004 season with an 8-3 record, defeating Norwich for the ECAC Northeast Championship in the season finale.
