

Alfred University men's basketball team earns 69-64 victory at Elmira

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's basketball team ended a two-game losing skid with a 69-64 win at Empire 8 Conference rival Elmira College Friday night. Junior guard Quentin Bryant (Buffalo, NY/Seneca Vocational) led Alfred (9-8, 3-3 Empire 8) with a game-high 21 points. Bryant made eight of 11 shots, including four of seven from three-point range. Junior forward Todd Dersham (Campbell, NY/Campbell-Savona) and senior guard Bruce Nober (Lake Huntingdon, NY/Narrowsburg) each scored nine points for the Saxons, while junior forward Ryan Hallett (Caledonia, NY/Caledonia-Mumford) added eight. Elmira (1-14, 1-5 Empire 8), which trailed by 12 points at intermission before rallying to make it close in the second half, outrebounded Alfred 40-27. The host team was paced by three players in double figures; Micah Owens with 17 points; Andy Frica with 14; and Serge Clement with 12. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, Jan. 29, at 4 p.m. at Ithaca.
