

Alfred University plans Engineering Career Fair

Alfred University's Career Development Center will hold an Engineering Career Fair from noon to 2 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 24, in the Knight Club, Powell Campus Center. The event is being held in conjunction with other School of Engineering events during National Engineers Week. This event is free and open to students, alumni, and community members. Professional dress is required for this event, and attendees are asked to take several copies of their resumes. Companies are recruiting for internship, co-op, and permanent positions. Most positions will require that a candidate have, or be pursuing, a college degree. A third-year career event sponsor, PPG, Inc. will be present at the event to speak with candidates about current openings.
