

## AU men's and women's alpine ski teams wrap up regular season at Syracuse

FABIUS, NY The Alfred University men's and women's alpine ski teams competed at Toggenburg Mountain over the weekend in a meet hosted by Syracuse University. Twelve teams competed, with the AU men's team placing second overall and the women's team sixth. The AU men qualified for the United States Collegiate Ski Association (USCSA) Mid-Atlantic Regionals, which will be held Feb. 25 and 26 at Bluemountain, PA. The top four teams at regionals will advance to the USCSA National Championships at Brundage Mountain, ID, March 7-12. The women's team ended its season after failing to qualify for the regional championships. Senior Matt Seavey (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) led the AU men's team, winning the giant slalom and slalom events and taking overall individual honors for the weekend. Seavey has finished atop the individual standings in all five of the regular season meets. Freshman Lincoln Steele (Keene, NH/Keene) placed seventh in the giant slalom and sixth in the slalom. Senior Jared Mostue (Hopkinton, NH/Proctor Academy), in the last regular season meet of his career, took eighth in the giant slalom, while sophomore Ben Cantor (Concord, NH/Kimball Union Academy) was 15th in giant slalom. Senior Anna Rung (Colden, NY/Springville) was the AU women's team's top skier, earning a 12th-place finish in the giant slalom and a 14th-place finish in the slalom. Sophomore Laura La Pierre (Maplecrest, NY/Windham-Ashland-Jewett) was 25th in the giant slalom and 27th in the slalom.
