

Two Alfred University women's basketball players among nation's statistical leaders

ALFRED, NY Two members of the Alfred University women's basketball team completed the 2004-05 season ranked among the nation's statistical leaders for Division III programs. Kylee Knoll (Elmira, NY/Elmira Free Academy) ranked 14th in the country in blocked shots per game with 2.6 per contest. Knoll, a junior center, blocked 66 shots in 25 games for the Lady Saxons. Senior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown, NY/Gen. Douglas MacArthur) ranked 15th in the country in three-point field goals made per game (2.7). Kelly, who finished her career with 198 three-pointers made (second all-time at AU), converted 62 three-point shots in 23 games in 2004-05.
