

## **May 30 memorial set for Caroline Littell**

The life of the late Caroline Littell of Alfred, travel photojournalist and a former director of Alfred University's language laboratory, will be celebrated in a remembrance ceremony Saturday, May 30 at 3 p.m. in the Church Center of the Union University Church, Church Street, in Alfred. All are invited to attend.

Mrs. Littell died March 18, 2015 in Pasadena, CA, where she had been in hospice care because of complications of acute leukemia. She was 75.

Born in Egypt of English parents, she was educated in England and later studied languages in France, Spain, Austria and Greece. For more than 30 years, her black-and-white and color photography illustrated articles on tourism and travel in dozens of newspapers and magazines in this country and in Europe.

Mrs. Littell immigrated to the United States in 1962. She moved to Alfred in 1968, when her husband, Alan Littell, a radio editorial writer in New York City, was appointed to the administrative staff of Alfred University.

The May 30 memorial will include a display of her published work.
